

# The Morning After

September 20, 2011

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Monday, September 19, 2011, President David Howard called the regular meeting of the River Ridge Community Unit School District #210 Board of Education; 4141 IL Rte 84 South; Hanover, IL, to order at 7:00 PM. Board Members David Howard, Barb Schaible, Raymie Diestelmeier, Merri Sevey and Matt Wild answered roll call. Member Don McLane entered the meeting at 7:02 PM and Member G. Allen Crist entered the meeting at 7:12 PM. Also present: Superintendent Brad Albrecht, Principal Mike Foltz, Principal Beau Buchs, representatives for the RREA and a River Ridge student.

The Board took the following action:

- Approved the retreat, budget hearing, regular and executive session minutes of the August 15, 2011 board meetings, August 26, 2011 special meeting and destruction of executive session minutes from February 16, 2010.
- Reviewed and accepted the Treasurer's Report, Investment Report and Activity Reports.
- Paid bills and payroll in the amount of \$570,750.19.
- Jo Daviess Carroll Area Vocational Center representative, Raymie Diestelmeier, presented the September 6, 2011 minutes. Enrollment for the 2011-2012 school year is 209. Bob Nolan will take care of snow removal. Building projects – restroom plumbing, tiling, masonry and painting and roof repairs are complete. The Regional Board of School Trustees will meet October 28, 2011 and may set a Public Hearing date for the Stockton School District Petition to Withdraw.
- Adopted the budget for the 2011-2012 school year as presented.
