On Mondays, students receive \$6.00 in pretend \$. They are to save their \$ all month long to earn the reward party and be able to purchase items from the classroom reward store.

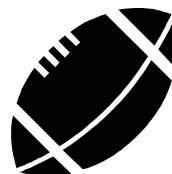
