Literacy:

This week, we had a fantastic time reading about the different kinds of bread and how bread is made~from seed to the delicious bread we eat. Our Treasure book was **The Little Red Hen**. Instead of treasure words, we made vocabulary cards by gluing a picture card to the word card. Ask your child to read the words at home.

We also read books, watched a movie, wrote, tasted and made bread! Yummy! We have started learning about the many animals that live on a farm. We made a rooster, a hen, a cow and learned facts and wrote about the animals.

Next week, we will begin our unit on pizza! We will spend the week learning about what grows on a pizza farm and end our week by eating pizza!
