

# Kindergarten News

**Literacy:** We spent this week learning our Zoo-phonics sounds and signals. Most of the students are catching on quickly. We will be using our sounds in words before you know it! We toured our building and got to know *all* our teachers. The entire Kindergarten took a *Brown Bear* walk and each one of our teachers had an animal on their door so we can easily remember where our classrooms are. An easy way for us to remember these rooms was to make a brown bear tour book in our classroom. This should be in the Friday folder today.

Next week we will start the **posters** and learning everybody's name in print. Your child will also start to learn some sightwords. We will continue with our Zoo-phonics instruction. **Please send in the posters Monday.**

**Math:** We started our calendar math. The count has started up to 100. We are adding a tally mark for each day of school. Place value is being learned by adding a straw to a pocket each day. Counting is a skill we work on daily.
